### Literacy

On Wednesday morning in assembly, we performed our version of 'Lazy Jack' to the rest of the school. The children have used their knowledge of nocturnal animals and presented the information in a variety of different ways. They have also had a writer's morning, planning and writing a story.

### Maths

In Maths this week, we have identified the features of 2D and 3D shapes. Some children have used the computers to increase their knowledge by sorting shapes and playing a question and answer game. The children have continued to use quick recall in mental maths.

### Music

This week, the children continued to revise open strings they were also introduced to A minor chord.
