

Week Beginning: 31st March 2014

Literacy

In Literacy on Tuesday, we explored acrostic poems. This led to us writing our own riverbank acrostic poem using words we had learnt throughout our topic.

The children have used their speaking and listening skills this week by practising readings and poetry for the Easter Service.

Maths

On Monday in Maths, we focussed on problem solving. We had to find all of the ways to make 45p and then 50p using only silver coins. We had to work in a logical and organised way so that we found all of them possible combinations. We have started to learn about reflective symmetry the children have used mirrors to complete the missing part of the shape.

Art

This week in Art, we added the finishing touches to our paper and paste river animals. We used paint and tissue paper for their fur/skin, before adding features such as eyes and whiskers etc.



RE

In RE, we explored the changing emotions of Holy Week in preparation for Easter. We focussed on the key events of Palm Sunday, the Last Supper, the Crucifixion and the Resurrection, and discussed the differing emotions that would have been felt by Christians and Jesus himself.

Music

On Thursday the children successfully preformed their Music Concert. The children sung a range of songs and used tuned percussion to show arrange of melodies.

As the children have worked extremely hard this half term, we won't be issuing any written homework or spellings over the holidays. However, our topic for next half term will focus on plants, so any reading or first hand experience in this area would be great!
