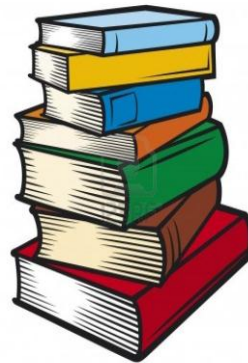
Literacy

This week has been 'Book Week'. Stingrays' chosen book was 'Man on the Moon (a day in the life of Bob)' by Simon Bartram. We have all enjoyed focussing on this book. The children have written a diary entry from the point of view of the main character. They have also written about the attractions on the Moon for the visitors.

The children have shared big books with the other children in the school. They were given the opportunity to swap books.

Art

This week in Art, we applied paste bandages to our river animals using strips of torn newspaper and paste. We had to make sure that we wrapped the bandages around our animal smoothly and tightly. Our animals need to be left to dry for a week before we add our finishing touches next week. We have also done art work linking to 'Book Week'.
