

Week Beginning: 27th January 2014

Literacy

In Literacy this week, we have continued our new module on information texts. We have identified key features of information texts, including the title, introduction, subheadings, pictures and captions. We have also used the contents, glossary and index to locate information within the book. We have looked at the layout and presentation of an information text, and have explored the differences between fact and opinion.

Maths

In Maths on Monday, we focussed on multiples. We used this knowledge on Tuesday to investigate some statements about multiples, such as *'If you double a multiple of 3, the answer will always be a multiple of 6.'* We had to find examples which proved the statements true or false. We have started looking at division as an inverse of multiplication.

Music

Children have explored the tuned percussion instruments. They have continued to practise high and low steps ensuring they control of the beater.



RE

In RE this week, we have continued our unit on the miracles of Jesus. We read and discussed the story 'Jesus Calms the Storm'. Following the theme of Christingle we have made our own in class with Reverend Julie for assembly.

French

We have continued to practise the names of our family. We have also learnt the words for Grandparents, Uncle and Aunt.
