

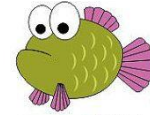
Expressive Arts and Design

Making Relationships, Self Confidence and Self Awareness and Managing Feelings and Behaviour

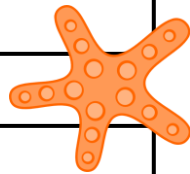
We enjoyed a visit from the pre-school children who will be joining us in September. The current YR children were lovely with them, looking after them and showing them some of the things they can do when they start school.

We have been working hard on our phonics this week. We have been finding words with the correct sounds in them and then matching and writing words to the correct pictures.
